Wickepin Cemetery - Community Consultation

The Shire of Wickepin recognises the deep cultural and historical significance of the four cemeteries within the shire and is committed to ensuring all cemeteries are preserved and enhanced in keeping with the natural features and landscape. In 2005 the Shire of Wickepin Townscape Committee identified a need for better planning and management of the Wickepin, Yealering, Harrismith, and Toolibin cemeteries and conducted on site inspections in order to recommend improvements. Implementing the plan could not proceed until funding could be obtained. The Shire of Wickepin has now secured funding as part of the Royalties for Regions – Country Local Government Fund and is keen to commence work on an upgrade of the Wickepin Cemetery. The final plans will need to fit within available funding limits.

The Shire of Wickepin recognises the need to consult with the community and affected families when carrying out any works that may impact directly on individual gravesites or niche walls. The improvements to the Wickepin Cemetery, recommended in the 2005 Cemetery Redevelopment Plan, are listed below. The Shire of Wickepin would appreciate feedback and comment on the recommendations prior to commencing any work on the project.

Pathways between Graves Seal with Corrigin pea gravel.

Improve formation to prevent water erosion.

Denomination/Row Plaques Repaint/coat all plaques.

Entrance/Parking Area Form and water bind. Seal with Corrigin pea gravel.

Roadways Improve formation to improve drainage and access.

Niche Wall/Gazebo Design new niche wall/gazebo Construct new niche wall/gazebo

Visitor Comfort and Amenity Shade.



APPLICATION TO JOIN A BUSH FIRE BRIGADE

It has come to our attention that a few bush fire volunteers are not properly registered. All people attending a bush fire must be registered with the Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES), previously known as FESA.

Those who attend bush fires and are not a registered Bush Fire Volunteer, may not be covered by insurance if anything does occur.

To register to become a Bush Fire Volunteer, contact your local brigade secretary for an application form, or come into the Shire Office to collect one to complete. All forms will need to be signed off by an authorised Brigade Captain or Secretary.

A word from the Community Development Officer...

With several projects finished in the first half of the year off my "To Do List", it is time to get started on some exciting new projects. In the next few weeks I will completing a funding application to develop a plan to extend, improve and renew the walk trails in the Shire of Wickepin. It is hoped that the plan will assist us to map out the best place for the trails, seating and interpretive signage. The plan is also expected to give us information on how to best display the buildings and machinery in the Wickepin Heritage Precinct as well as showcase our natural assets at Yealering and Harrismith.

I am working with the Townscape and Cultural Planning Committee and a small working group on developing some plaques at the Wickepin War Memorial to acknowledge the local residents who died during various wars.

I will be looking for plenty of comments and feedback from community members on a proposed upgrade to the Wickepin Cemetery and refurbishment of the gardens at the Shire of Wickepin offices. I have also started

working on some tourism and marketing projects as well as plenty of other small community ideas. The new round of Royalties for Regions funding is expected to be received very soon and I will

start work on the upgrade of the Wickepin Cemetery and improvements at the Yealering Lake, Bowling Green and Golden Memorial Park.

Several applications for the Shire of Wickepin Community Grants were received and I look forward to working with local community and sporting groups to put their plans into action once Council has decided on the successful applications in the new financial year.
