

### Great news for Lake Yealering & Lake Ewlyamartup \$3.7 million to revitalise regional lakes

Monday, 21 November 2016

- \$3.7 million to revitalise lakes in Wheatbelt and Great Southern regions
- · Lake Yealering and Lake Ewlyamartup to be enhanced
- · Made possible by Liberal National Government's Royalties for Regions program

Regional Development Minister Terry Redman today announced the enhancement of the Yealering and Ewlyamartup lakes, thanks to a \$3.7 million Liberal National Government investment through the Royalties for Regions Living Lakes Stage 3 initiative.

Mr Redman said the project would employ creative engineering solutions to improve water quality and create permanent and accessible water bodies for the enjoyment of local communities and tourists.

"Investment in these lakes will re-establish native flora and fauna, attract visitors and deliver economic returns to the communities," he said.

"Lake Yealering in the Wheatbelt and Lake Ewlyamartup in the Great Southern are both integral to their communities.

"This investment, through the Royalties for Regions Living Lakes initiative, will increase opportunities for bird watching, boating, swimming and water-skiing.


"This revitalisation will boost visitation to these lakes, helping to bring tourism dollars to surrounding communities as well as providing environmental and social benefits."

Engineering improvements to both lakes are aimed at increasing the average number of days each year with water depth greater than 1.5 metres, as well as significantly improving the quality of the water.

The Living Lakes initiative will complement the improvements made by the local communities to the amenity of the lakes.

- 1. Sample the vodka to check the quality.
- Take a large bowl, check the vodka again.
- 3. To be sure it is of the highest quality, pour one level cup and mix with a little red bull and drink.
- 4. Repeat.
- 5. Turn on the electric mixer, beat one cup of butter in a large fluffy bowl.
- 6. Add one teaspoon of sugar. Beat again.
- 7. At this point its is best to make sure the vodka is still ok.
- 8. Flavour with red bull to taste.
- 9. Try another cup just in case turn off the mixerer.
- 10. Break two leggs and add to the bowl and chuck in the cup of dried fruit.
- 11. Pick fruit off floor
- 12. Mix on the turner.
- 13. If the dried fruit gets stuck in the beaterers, pry it loose with a drewscriver.
- 14. Shample the vodka to check for tonsisticitity, flavour with a little Bed Rull.
- 15. Next ssiffft two cups of salt. Or something ... Who giveshz a shi\*\*
- 16. Throw a pinch of Bed Rull over your shoulder
- 17. Pick up the can, mop the floor
- 18. Check the vodka
- 19. Now shift the lemon juice and strain your nuts.
- 20. Add one table.
- 21. Add a shpoon of shugar, or somefink. Whatever you can find.
- 22. Turn the cake tin 360 degrees and try not to fall over..
- 23. Don't forget to beat off the turner
- 24. Finally, throw the bowl through the window, finish the vodka and kick the dog.

25. Fall into bed.

#### IN THE KITCHEN

#### ROAST PORK WITH BACON & CRANBERRY STUFFING

SERVES 8 PREP 40 MIN COOK 2 HR

- · 2.cloves garlic, crushed
- 4 chopped spring/green onions
- 4 pieces shortcut bacon, diced
- ½ cup dried cranberries
- 1 cup fresh white breadcrumbs
- 2kg boned and rolled pork loin
- Cranberry Gravy, to serve (see below)

1 Heat 1 tablespoon oil in a pan, add the garlic, chopped spring/green onions and bacon. Cook for 4-5 min. Remove from the heat and add the cranberries and breadcrumbs. Season to taste with black pepper. Mix well. 2 Preheat oven to 230°C

(210°C fan forced). Lay pork loin flat with the rind scored and spread with stuffing mixture.

- 3 Roll up and tie in place using kitchen string, starting at one end and looping string over and around as you secure the string down the length of the pork, knotting in place.
- 4 Place pork into a roasting pan, skin side up. Rub with a little oil and salt then season with pepper. Roast for

20 min. reduce oven to 210°C (190°C fan forced) and cook pork for 2 hr. Transfer to serving plate and allow to stand for 10-15 min before removing string to carve. Serve pork slices with Cranberry Gravy, roast vegies and steamed green beans. CRANBERRY GRAVY Pour 1/2 cup cooking juices from the roast pork into a pan. Add 1/3 cup gravy powder, mix well. Whisk in 2 cups chicken stock, stir over low heat until thick and smooth. Stir in 1/3 cup cranberry sauce and season with pepper.



#### CHOC-CHIP MINI PAVLOVAS WITH ICE-CREAM

SERVES 6 PREP 15 MIN + COOLING TIME COOK 1HR 30 MIN

- 4 eggwhites
- ½ cup each raw caster and caster sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup coarsely grated chocolate
- 1L chocolate ice-cream
- 1½ cups chocolate sauce
- crushed candy canes and spearmint lolly leaves, to decorate
- 1 Preheat oven to 120°C (110°C fan forced). Line

a large baking tray with baking paper and draw 6 x 10cm circles on the baking paper with lead pencil, then turn over. 2 Whisk eggwhites with a pinch of salt until soft peaks form. Gradually add sugars and continue beating for 6-8 min or until thick and glossy, and sugar has dissolved. Fold through the vanilla and grated chocolate. 3 Divide the meringue mixture between circles. Using the back of a spoon, spread meringue to the edge of each circle and make an indent in the centre to form a shallow bowl. Bake in the oven for 1hr 30 min. Turn oven off and leave to cool completely. These can be made up to 4 days in advance and kept in an airtight container.



4 To serve, scoop the chocolate ice-cream into the centre of each meringue and drizzle with chocolate sauce. Top with candy canes and mint lolly leaves.

The ladies Championship fours was cancelled due to bad weather on November 16th. This event will be played later on.


