- > Establish a point of interest and difference in town.



# IN THE KITCHEN

### Easy pasta with chicken and chorizo meatballs

### **Ingredients:**

- 500g large spiral pasta
- 2 chorizo sausages, casings removed, roughly chopped
- 500g chicken mince
- 1 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 red onion, thinly sliced
- 3 garlic cloves, crushed
- 700g tomato pasta sauce
- 150g baby spinach
- 1 cup torn fresh basil leaves, plus extra basil leaves, to serve
- 180g tub baby bocconcini, drained




### Method

- Step 1: Cook the pasta in a large saucepan of salted boiling water until al dente. Drain and keep warm.
- Step 2: Meanwhile, place the chorizo in a food processor and process until finely chopped.
   Add the chicken mince and process until well combined. Roll tablespoonfuls of the mixture into meatballs and place on a lined baking tray.
- Step 3: Heat the oil in a large, non-stick frying pan over medium heat. Cook the meatballs, in batches, for 2-3 minutes or until golden. Transfer to a plate. Add the onion to the pan and cook, stirring, for 2-3 minutes or until softened. Stir in the garlic and tomato pasta sauce and bring to a simmer. Return the meatballs to the pan and cook, stirring, for 5 minutes or until cooked through. Stir in the spinach until just wilted. Stir in basil.
- Step 4: Preheat the oven grill on high. Place the pasta in a 3L (12-cup) ovenproof baking dish. Pour the meatball mixture over the pasta and scatter the bocconcini on top. Place under the grill and cook for 3-5 minutes or until the cheese is golden and melted. Serve sprinkled with extra basil leaves. Easy pasta with chicken and chorizo meatballs.

### Homemade Peanut Butter.

- 500 gm roasted unsalted peanuts and 1/2 teaspoon oil.
- Using a food processor process peanuts until very finely chopped. Scrape down side of bowl and add oil. Process for 30 seconds. Scrape down side of bowl.
   Process for another 30 seconds and scrape down side of bowl. Repeat process another 1-2 times or until smooth. Season with salt if you like.





#### Are you interested in the biosecurity of Western Australia's agricultural industries?

Western Australian producers and other stakeholders in the dairy, beef, grain/seed, hay, sheep and/or goat industries and respective supply chains are invited to apply for positions on Industry Funding Scheme Management Committees.

<u>Industry Funding Schemes</u> enable agricultural industries to raise funds to address priority pests and diseases at a whole-of-industry level.

The schemes are industry-driven and overseen by a Management Committee made up of producers and other stakeholders with appropriate industry knowledge and expertise.

Members of the committees are appointed by the Minister for Agriculture and Food for a period of up to three years. Support is provided to the schemes and management committees by the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development.

From 1 July 2019, there will be vacancies on the following Management Committees:

- <u>Cattle Industry Funding Scheme</u> (6 positions)
- Grains, Seeds and Hay Industry Funding Scheme (5 positions)
- Sheep and Goat Industry Funding Scheme (4 positions)

Committees meet quarterly on dates agreed by members, and members are remunerated, including sitting fees and travel expenses.

The committee terms of reference, the selection criteria for members of the Management Committees, and guidelines for expressions of interest are available on the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development website at agric.wa.gov.au. Search for 'Industry Management Committee terms'.

The Western Australian Government is committed to ensuring diversity on Government boards and committees and, in particular, increasing the representation of women to 50 per cent by 2019.
