TWISTED DESIRE LEMON COCONUT SLICE

SLICE

Warm together

½ cup condensed milk

125g butter

Mix together

250g (1 packet) Arrowroot biscuits, crushed

1 cup coconut

Add to dry mix

Zest and juice of 1 lemon

Milk/butter mixture

Mix well

Press into slice tin and refrigerate. Ice when cool.

ICING

Beat together

60g Philly cheese – softened

30g butter - softened

Till smooth and creamy.

Add

2 tsp lemon juice

1½ cups icing sugar, sifted - add gradually

Beat until combined.

5 MINUTE CHOCOLATE MUG CAKE

4 tablespoons flour

4 tablespoons sugar

2 tablespoons cocoa

1 egg

3 tablespoons milk

3 tablespoons oil

3 tablespoons chocolate chips (optional)

1 large coffee mug or pyrex jug if using SR flour

Add dry ingredients to mug and mix well. Add the egg – mix thoroughly.

Pour in the milk and oil and mix well. Add the chocolate chips (if using) and vanilla extract - mix again.

Place in microwave and cook for 3 minutes at 1000 watts.

The cake will rise over the top of the mug, but don't be alarmed???

Allow to cool a little and tip out onto a plate if desired.

This can serve 2 if you want to share???

If you have strawberries that have grown too large, take the new runners and pot them up for next season. Put them up off the ground to prevent them being eaten by unwanted hunger pests.







