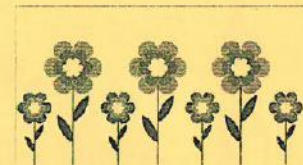


Narrogin Senior High school Art Exhibition at the Nexis Gallery. This exhibition is open from 10am to 4pm until the 13th November. Local students art is on display.

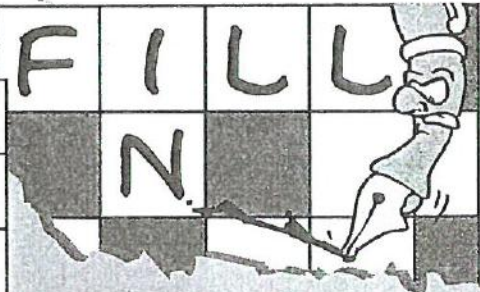
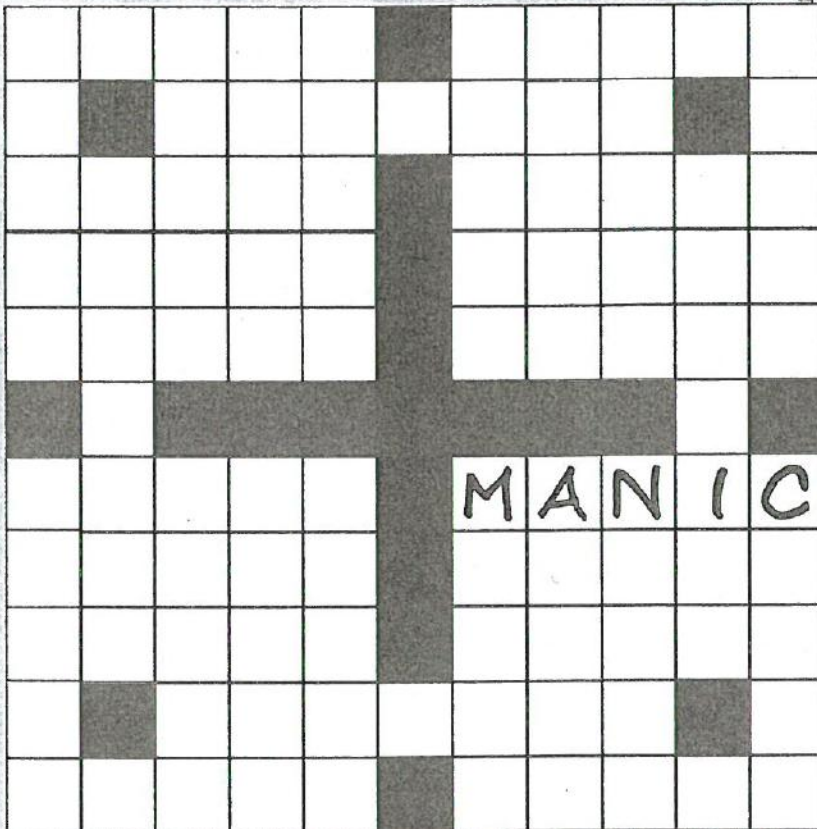

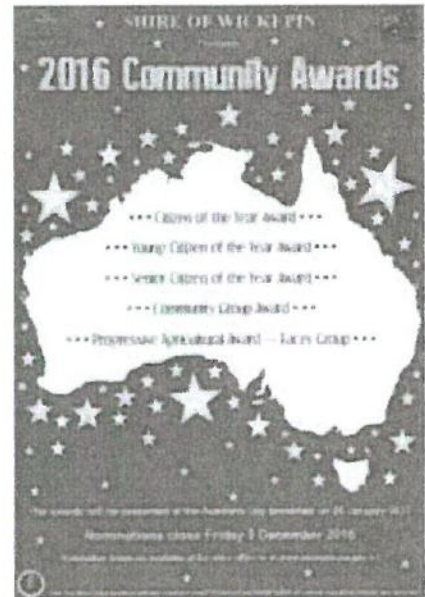
The categories are as follows;

JUST SIX MINUTES...

It only takes 6 minutes for a dog to die in a hot car.

Do not leave your dog in a vehicle. Pets can overheat even when the windows are down or the car is in the shade.

How fast does the temperature rise in a car?

Temperatures in a car can rise to dangerous levels and can rapidly reach more than double the outside temperature even on mild days. Tinting, parking in the shade or leaving the windows open do not help to reduce the inside temperature significantly.



Ute trays can burn

Dogs travelling on the back of utes can burn their footpads or bodies on the tray as these can get very hot in the sun. If you own a ute you should cover the trays with a suitable material and provide a shaded area.

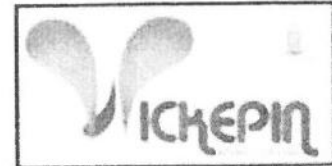

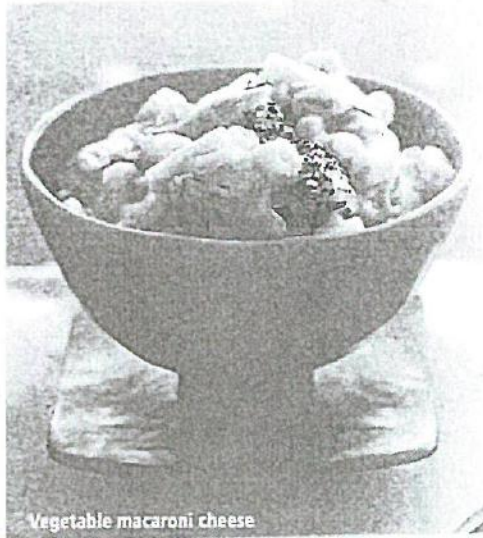

IN THE KITCHEN



Vegetable macaroni cheese

Vegetable macaroni cheese

Serves 4

- 30g butter, chopped
- 1 tablespoon plain flour
- 1 cup milk
- ¼ cup grated carrot
- ¼ cup grated zucchini
- ¼ cup canned corn kernels
- 50g broccoli, cut into florets
- 1 cup cooked macaroni pasta
- ½ cup grated cheddar cheese

1 Melt butter in a saucepan over medium heat. Add flour and cook, stirring, for 1 minute. Remove saucepan from heat. Gradually stir in milk. Return saucepan to heat. Cook, stirring, for 3 to 4 minutes or until sauce boils and thickens.

2 Add carrot, zucchini, corn, broccoli and macaroni. Cook for 5 minutes or until vegetables are soft. Stir in cheese. Cook for 2 to 3 minutes or until melted. Spoon into bowls and serve.

Tip You can store any leftover macaroni cheese in an airtight container in the fridge for up to 2 days. Add a little extra milk or water when reheating.

Smoked salmon on potato rosti

TIP: This fresh and tasty dish makes a fantastic summer brunch!

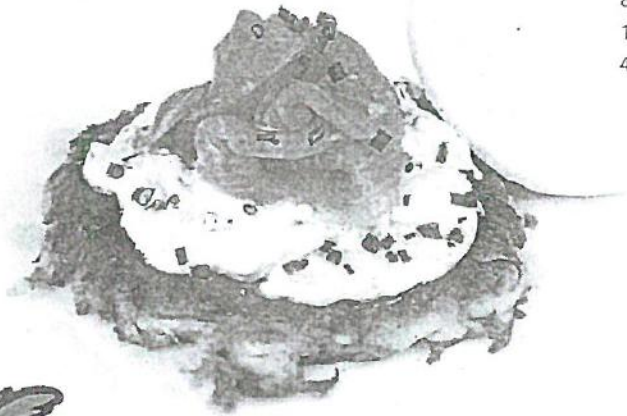
Serves 4

Ingredients

- 125mls (½ cup) sour cream
- 1 Lebanese cucumber, julienne
- Small bunch fresh dill, finely chopped
- Half a lemon
- 800g (about 4) Royal Blue potatoes, peeled
- 2 eggs, lightly whisked
- 35g (¼ cup) self-raising flour
- 1 tbsp milk
- 2 tbsp light extra virgin olive oil
- 300g (16 slices) smoked salmon
- Salt and ground black pepper, to taste
- Chives to garnish
- Lemon wedges, to serve

Method

1. Combine sour cream, cucumber and dill, squeeze the juice from half a lemon and set aside.
2. To make potato rosti, coarsely grate the potatoes, place in a colander and rinse under cold running water. Drain well.
3. Place the grated potato on a dry tea towel and squeeze out all the moisture. Transfer to a bowl, add eggs, self-raising flour, milk and salt and pepper and stir with a fork until well combined.
4. Heat the light olive oil in a large non-stick frying pan over a medium to high heat. Flatten the potato in a round pattie (about 10cm in diameter) and add to the pan.
5. Cook for 3-5 minutes each side or until golden and cooked through. Remove from pan and drain on a paper towel. Keep warm. Repeat with the remaining potato mixture.
6. Place each rosti on a serving plate. Top with a spoonful of the sour cream mixture, followed by slices of smoked salmon
7. Garnish with fresh chives and cracked pepper. Serve with lemon wedges.

Dissolve 3 kgs of sugar in 2lts of boiling water.
Add 25gms of Citric acid, 25gms of Tartaric acid and 2 tablespoons of Epsom salts. Dissolve

Add juice and rind, stir, and bottle.

Makes 4.5lts of cordial

CHOCOLATE TORTE PAVLOVA WITH CARAMEL SAUCE

by Celeste and Hannah Jackson

SERVES 12
PREP 30 MIN
COOK 1 HR 30 MIN

- 8 egg whites
- 2 cups caster sugar
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 tablespoons Dutch cocoa powder
- 2 cups thickened cream
- ¼ cup icing sugar
- 2 cups chocolate covered honeycomb, coarsely crushed
- ½ cup grated dark chocolate
- ½ cup dark chocolate curls, made using a vegetable peeler
- Salted Butterscotch Sauce, to serve (see below)

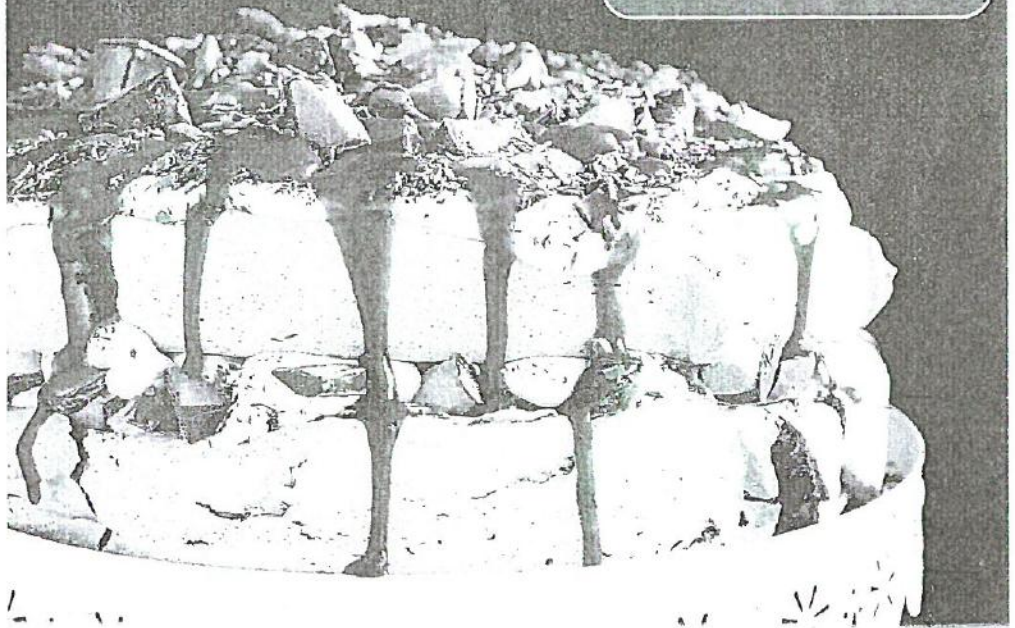
1 Preheat the oven to 220°C (200°C fan forced). Line 2 flat baking trays with baking paper and draw a 20cm round onto each sheet. Beat egg whites in a large bowl until soft peaks form then gradually add the sugar spoon by spoon, beating well between each addition, until thick and glossy. Add 1 teaspoon of vanilla and beat to combine.

2 Sift cocoa powder over meringue mix. Using a metal spoon, quickly fold through. Shape meringue between the 2 rounds on the baking paper. Place into oven and immediately reduce temperature to 120°C (100°C fan forced). Bake for 1 hr 30 min. Turn off oven, allowing meringue to fully cool in oven.

3 Meanwhile, beat thickened cream, icing sugar and remaining 1 teaspoon vanilla in a bowl until thickened. Cover and chill until required.

4 To assemble, place one pavlova onto a serving plate. Spread half the cream mixture over the top with half each of the honeycomb and grated chocolate. Top with remaining meringue, cream, honeycomb and grated chocolate. Sprinkle with chocolate curls and drizzle with Salted Butterscotch Sauce. Serve immediately.

I love that Mum makes this for special occasions. It's a decadent treat for all of us. Sometimes we serve it with fresh berries on the side. – Hannah

syrup and a dash of vanilla. Stir over low heat until the sugar is dissolved. Increase heat and boil for 3-4 min. Add ¼ teaspoon sea salt flakes. Allow to cool.
