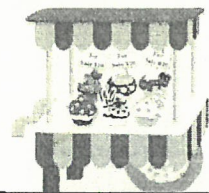

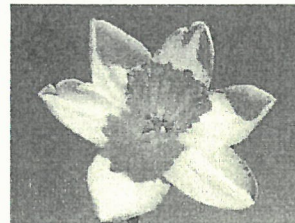

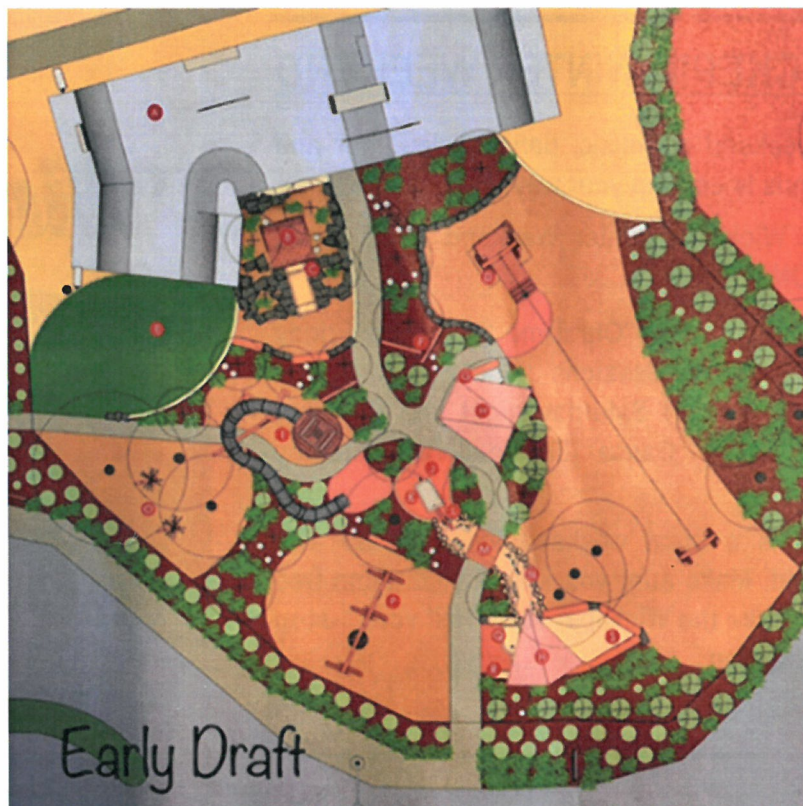
## WOGOLIN ROAD PARK

MAKES: 12

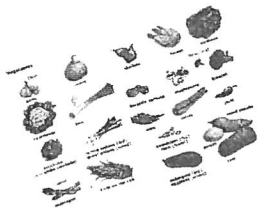
- ✪ 1 egg white

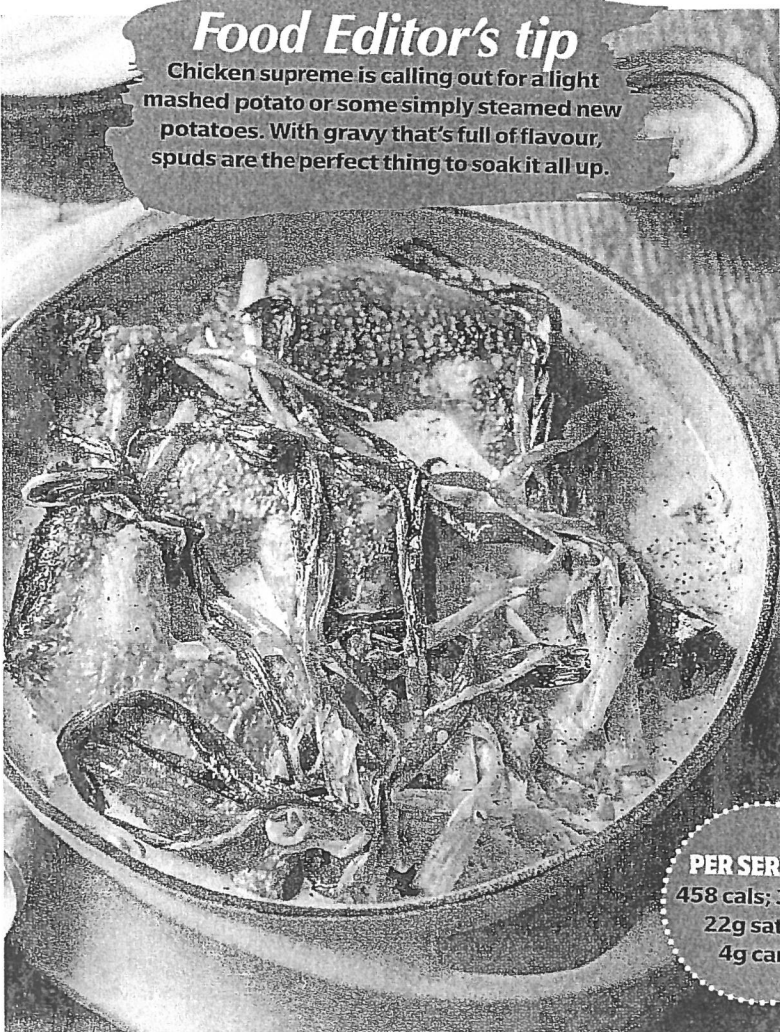

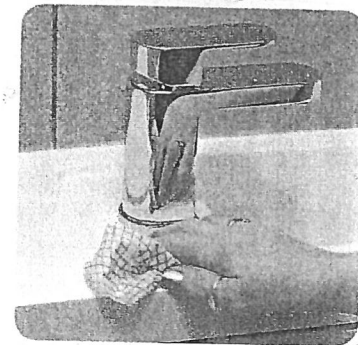

- ✪ 1 garlic clove, sliced
- ✪ 1 chicken stock cube
- ✪ 250ml (8fl oz) double cream
- ✪ 250ml (8fl oz) water

1 Fry the chicken legs, until they're well browned and almost cooked

through – about 10-12 mins a side, on a medium heat. Set aside to rest.

2 Fry the spring onions, remove and set aside. Fry the onion for 10 mins until translucent. Add the garlic, cook for another min, then stir in the stock cube, cream and water.

3 Return the chicken to the pan and cook for 15 mins to heat through and finish cooking the meat. Top with the spring onions to serve.

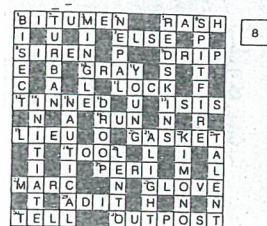
